D. Water Sample and District Agent Report – December 2023

The Secy./Treas. presented the District Agent's Monthly Report. The meter is not tracking water production currently. Static 19.2, Dynamic 75.2. Static low for the month 19.2

Coliform/Fecal testing per the sample site plan came back negative. Samples were taken at 590 McKinney Rubicon Springs in McKinney Estates.
